



# NRS Petro Release Update 2.9

January 2025

## Auto-Close

As a convenience feature, if no change is due when fueling completes, the transaction will close out without any intervention from the merchant.

## Transactions will auto close for:

- Cash transactions where the cash tendered amount equals the authorized and fueled amounts
- Cash transactions where the cash tendered amount was larger than the authorized amount but the cash was returned and the fueled amount equals the authorized amount
- Credit or debit transactions regardless of whether the full authorized amount was dispensed

The above is true regardless of whether merchandise accompanies the fueling or not.

Transactions will only auto-close if the register is available. Otherwise it will wait until it becomes available. **The following events prevent the auto-close from triggering:**

- Active basket at the register
- Order fulfillment
- The focus is elsewhere besides the register (pricebook, users etc.)
- “Change Due” modal
- Auto batching of the PAX
- Held basket loading or viewing the held basket queue
- BOSS Club screen
- Marketplace screen

The cash drawer will not open and there is no audio signal during auto-close of a transaction.

Manual close outs are still possible.

Post-Pay fuelings are not candidates for Auto-Close

The Auto-Close can be toggled on or off from the Petro configuration page.
